



Healthy Marketplace Index

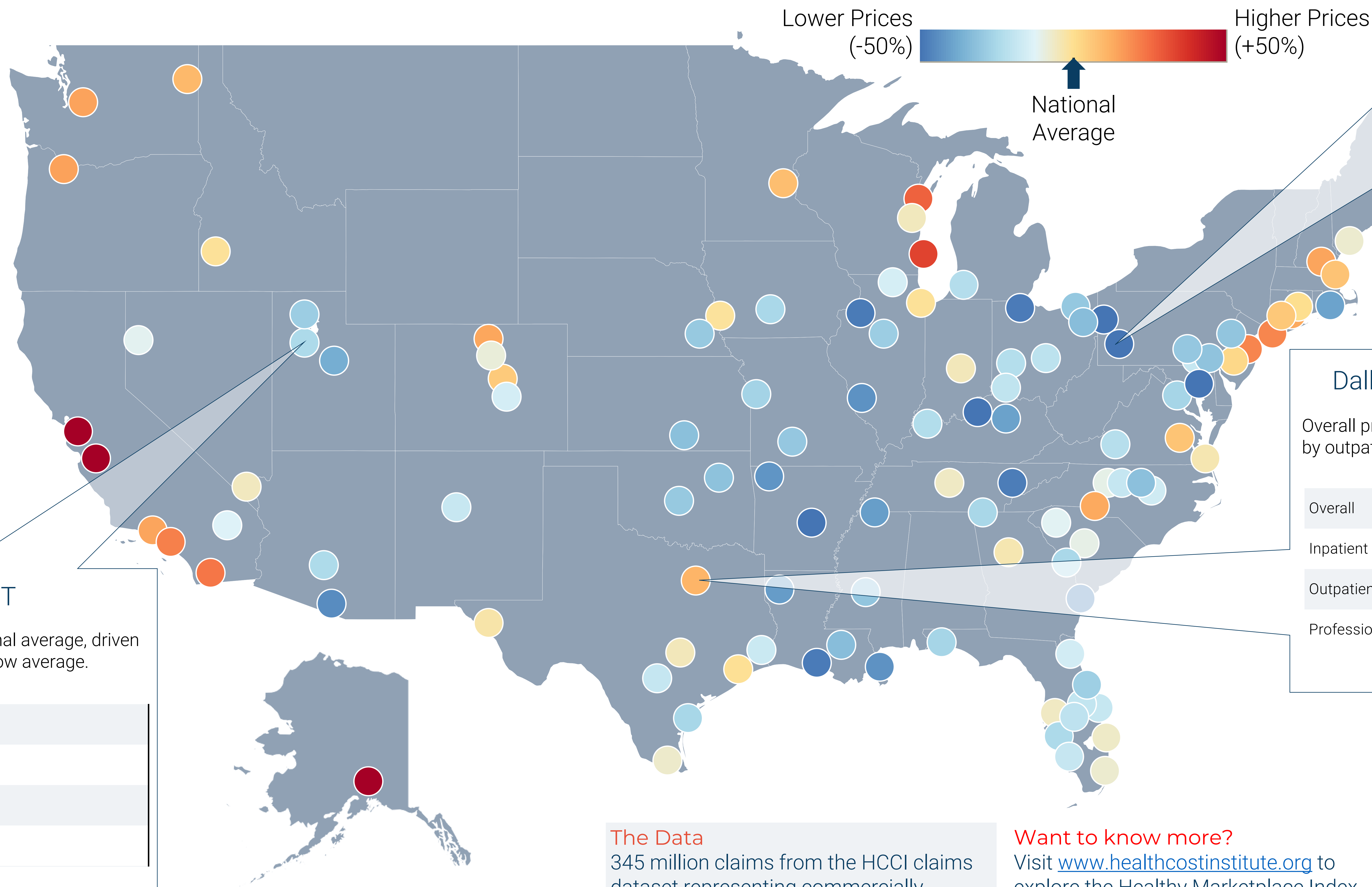
How expensive is health care in *your* area?

Are health care prices in your city above average?

We compared the average prices paid for the same set of health care services in 112 local areas across the country.

What services are contributing to higher prices?

We compared prices for inpatient, outpatient, and professional (clinician) services.



Pittsburgh, PA

Overall prices are 27% below the national average, driven by outpatient prices that were 38% below average.

Overall prices are 5% above the national average, driven by outpatient prices that were 12% above average.
